Motion passed unanimously.

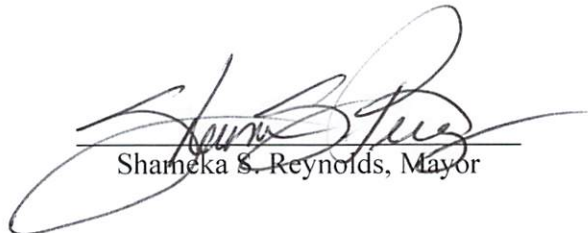
